THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 42-77

Being a by-law to amend By-law Numbers 808, 818 and 825 as amended of the former Township of Toronto Gore.

The Council of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law Number 808, 818 and 825 as amended by the former Township of Toronto Gore, and the same are, hereby amended to permit the lands described on Schedule 'A' annexed hereto, to be used only for the following purpose.


The lands shown on Schedule 'A' and designated as Commercial (C1) may be used for a commercial use, being a reception hall only, in addition to the present residential use, as defined by By-law 825 as amended.

- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section V111, Subsection 2(I) of By-law 825 as amended, the following regulations shall apply;
 - (a) Off-street parking shall be provided on the basis of one space for each three persons of hall capacity.
- 3. This by-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.
