To accept and assume as public highways certain lands on Registered Plan 43M-476 and to establish certain lands as parts of public highways

The streets and street widenings shown on Registered 1. Plan 43M-476 and dedicated as public highways, as described firstly in Schedule A to this by-law, are hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system.

2. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as described secondly and thirdly in Schedule A to this by-law, are hereby established as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.
