BY-LAW

Number 43-2012
To amend By-law 399-2002, as amended,
The Sign By-law

WHEREAS; the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 124-2005 on April 25, 2005 which added provisions to the Sign By-law for signage in conjunction with a home occupation, and

WHEREAS an increase in size to a sign identifying a home occupation provides more visibility to home based businesses;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows.

THAT By-law 399-2002, as amended, is hereby further amended

- 1) by changing thereto Section 8 EXEMPTIONS, Sentence(16) to read:

8.(16) One non-illuminated sign attached to the first floor of a building in conjunction with a permitted home occupation as per the City of Brampton Zoning By-law 270-2004, as amended, providing the sign does not exceed 0.35 m² (3.75 ft²) in sign area. Sign boxes shall be prohibited for a home occupation.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this **22nd** day of **February, 2012**.


