BY-LAW

Number 45-2005
To authorize the transfer of easement over
Part of Lot 13, Concession 3 EHS designated
as Part 2 on Plan 43R-29247

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a transfer of easement over Part of Lot 13, Concession 3 EHS designated as Part 2 on Plan 43R-29247 (the "Land") be conveyed to The Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Region");

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed to the City for nominal consideration by the owner of the abutting lands and the Region requires an easement over the Land for the purpose of traffic signalization at the intersection of Dixie Road and Springtown Trail;

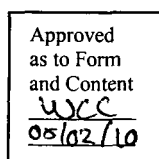
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over the Land in favour of the Region is hereby authorized; and
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement over the Lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of February, 2005.
