BY-LAW

Number 48-92

To prohibit the manufacture,
display, marketing for sale or
sale of a replica of a firearm
in the City of Brampton

WHEREAS the manufacture, display, marketing for sale and sale of replicas of firearms in the City of Brampton are activities having the potential to be harmful to the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Brampton:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. In this by-law
 - (a) "firearm" means any barrelled weapon from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged by means of rimfire or centre-fire ammunition and that is capable of causing serious bodily harm or death;
 - (b) "replica of a firearm" means a toy or other object that is not a firearm but might reasonably be mistaken for a firearm and, without restricting the generality of the foregoing, shall include compressed air and compressed carbon dioxide powered b-b and pellet guns that might reasonably be mistaken for a firearm.
2. Subject to Section 3, no person shall manufacture, display, market for sale or sell a replica of a firearm in the City of Brampton.
3. This by-law shall not apply to the manufacture, display, marketing for sale or sale of a replica of a firearm for or in connection with lawful use in:
 - (a) motion pictures, television, and stage productions; and
 - (b) historical displays or educational programs of a public museum.
4. Every person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and, on conviction, is liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of April, 1992.
