Number 49-90

To change the name of Morris Avenue
(Registered Plan M-350)

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of Morris Avenue;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in The Brampton Guardian and the Brampton Times, newspapers having general circulation in the City of Brampton;


AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The name of the street shown as "Morris Avenue" on Registered Plan M-350 as described in Schedule A attached hereto is changed to "Morris Court".
2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.

I, LEONARD J. MIKULICH, City Clerk and Director of Administration for The Corporation of the City of Brampton, MAKE OATH AND SAY THAT:



PUBLIC NOTICE OF CHANGE OF STREET NAME**


TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton proposes to enact a by-law pursuant to paragraph 105 of section 210 of the Municipal Act, changing the name of the public highway shown on Registered Plan M-350 as Morris Avenue as follows:

1. "Morris Avenue" on Registered Plan M-350 to be changed to and be known as part of "Morris Court".

A plan showing the location of this change of street name may be inspected at the office of the Clerk during normal business hours. The proposed by-law will come before Council for consideration at its regular meeting in the Council Chambers at the municipal offices, 150 Central Park Drive, Brampton, on the 9th day of April, 1990 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, and at that time, the Council will hear any person who claims that he will be adversely affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard.


