A By-law to amend By-law Number 145-74.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law Number 145-74, being a By-law to prohibit or regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height and location of buildings on part of Lot 4, Concession 2, E.H.S., City of Brampton, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Section 2.3 and 3.5.

2. Section 2.3 - Permitted Use

a) Catalogue centre not to exceed a gross floor area of Thirty thousand, three hundred (30,300) square feet occupying a building shown as Building Area "B" as shown on Schedule "A" hereto attached.

Section 3.5 - Parking

a) For a Catalogue centre at least one hundred and thirty-seven (137) parking spaces shall be provided

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 23rd day of February, 1976.


