BY-LAW

Number 52-82

To amend By-law 33-79, as amended


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 33-79 as amended, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic on City of Brampton highways, is hereby further amended by section (5) to Part 4 as follows:
 - "(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of this by-law which permits the parking of vehicles on highways, no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the clearing of snow from the highway."
2. Said By-law 33-79 is hereby further amended by adding paragraph E) to subsection 1 of section (3) of Part 6 as follows:
 - "E) Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) in respect of an alleged violation of the provisions relating to parking or standing so as to interfere with the clearing of snow from a highway."
3. Said By-law 33-79 is hereby further amended by adding section (4) to Part 6 as follows:
 - "(4) i) Notwithstanding section 1 of Part 6 of this by-law, every person who contravenes section 5 of Part 4 of this by-law is guilty of an offence and, upon summary conviction, is liable to a penalty of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first offence, and not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each subsequent offence, exclusive of costs.
 - ii) Where a police officer or a constable finds any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of section 4 of Part 4 of this by-law, he may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for

removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by section 52 of the Mechanics' Lien Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 261, as amended)."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of March, 1982.
