# **BY-LAW**

Λ	Number	, 5	53-93	

To amend By-law 141-92 being a by-law to provide for the maintenance, management, regulation and control of certain cemeteries within the City of Brampton

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 141-92 on June 22, 1992 to provide for the maintenance, management, regulation and control of certain cemeteries within the City of Brampton. The purpose of this by-law is to revise the fee schedule to By-law 141-92 and to make other revisions recommended by the Cemeteries Regulation Branch of the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 141-92 is hereby amended:
- (1) by deleting the words "the following" from the second line in section 16 and by substituting therefor the word "follows";
- (2) by adding after subsection 16(2), subsection 16(3) as
  follows:
  - (3) In the case of an in-ground lot that is sold after having been repurchased in accordance with section 23 of the <u>Cemeteries Act (Revised)</u>, the greater of the amount determined by subsection (1) or (2) of this section, whichever is applicable, or the amount that is the difference between the sale price and the repurchase price of the lot.
- (3) by deleting subsection 32(2) and by substituting therefor the following:
  - (2) As provided by subsection 44(2) of the Cemeteries Act (Revised), the City may charge the interment rights holder for the cost of repair, stabilization or restoration of a monument, marker or memorial on lots that were sold before 1955 and where payment to the Care and Maintenance Fund has not been made. The charge shall be as set out in Section III of Schedule B to this By-law.

- (4) by deleting from the first line of subsection 42(5) the words "in the opinion of the Manager";
- (5) by deleting Schedule B and by substituting as Schedule B, Schedule A to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this  $29 \mathrm{th}$  day of March, 1993.
