

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

53-2006

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1668
WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;
<b>AND WHEREAS,</b> pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;
<b>AND WHEREAS,</b> the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning</i> Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance

**NOW THEREFORE,** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

easements with respect to single detached lots 90 and 220, is to the satisfaction of the City of

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lots 90 and 220, on Registered Plan 43M-1668;

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on February 13, 2007.
