

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 55-75

A By-law to make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day.


WHEREAS the Shriners represent that they are a corporation incorporated without share capital;


AND WHEREAS the said Corporation proposes to hold a circus on Sunday, the 11th day of May, 1975;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of The Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 259 is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton in respect of the activities hereinafter specified, namely a circus at Brampton Memorial Arena, Elliott Street South, Brampton, conducted by the Shriners.
2. The said activities specified in clause 1 shall be limited to the period between the hours of 1:00 and 10:00 o'clock in the afternoon of Sunday, the 11th day of May, 1975.
3. The Shriners shall conduct the activities hereby permitted in an orderly manner.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 7th day of April, 1975.
