To authorize the conveyance of the former Brampton Brick Spur Line lands

WHEREAS the lands described in Schedule A to this By-law are no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The conveyance of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law to the abutting property Owners to the south of the lands for a proportionate share of the legal, survey and fencing costs incurred by the City in connection with this transaction, is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor necessary to affect the conveyances.
