# BY-LAW

Number 55-89


To authorize the acquisition of  
Mount Olivet Cemetery


WHEREAS the Church Extension Council of Dufferin and Peel Presbytery of the United Church of Canada has requested The Corporation of the City of Brampton to take over Mount Olivet Cemetery located on the lands described in Schedule A hereto;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The acquisition of Mount Olivet Cemetery, comprising the lands described in Schedule A hereto, from the Church Extension Council of Dufferin and Peel Presbytery of the United Church of Canada for the sum of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement dated the 13th day of February, 1989, between the Church Extension Council of Dufferin and Peel Presbytery of the United Church of Canada and The Corporation of the City of Brampton respecting the conveyance of Mount Olivet Cemetery to the City.
3. Upon obtaining title to Mount Olivet Cemetery, The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall maintain and operate Mount Olivet Cemetery in accordance with the provisions of the Cemeteries Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 59, as amended) and the regulations passed thereunder.
4. The Treasurer shall deposit all funds received pursuant to the said agreement in a special account, and shall ensure that the funds are expended only for the maintenance and care of Mount Olivet Cemetery.
5. This by-law comes into effect upon approval of the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations.

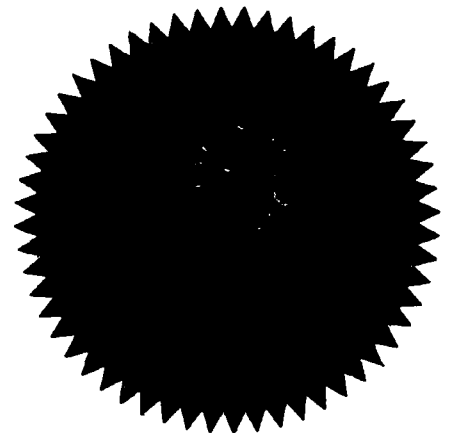
