Number 56-95

To declare surplus and authorize
the transfer of easement in favour
of Bell Canada

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has considered requests from Bell Canada for transfers of easement over the lands described in this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The easement rights over the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
2. The transfer of easement to Bell Canada over the lands described in Column 1 of Schedule A attached hereto for the price set out in Column 2 of Schedule A attached hereto, is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the transfers of easement in a form approved by the City Solicitor together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the said transfers of easement.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of March, 1995.
