1. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the Town of Brampton, the predecessor to The Corporation of the City of Brampton, described in Schedule A to this bylaw are hereby established as part of the public highway system, to be part of McLaughlin Road.

## SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 56-96

The land situated in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel) being composed of part of Block B as shown on a Plan registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel as Number G-23 which may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the most Southerly angle of said Block B;

**THENCE** Northwesterly along the Southwesterly limit of said  $Block \ B \ 126.62$  feet.

THENCE Northeasterly and parallel to the Southeasterly limit of said Block B 10.07 feet more or less to the intersection of a line lying northeasterly and parallel to and being 10.00 feet in perpendicular distance from the said Southwesterly limit of said Block B.

**THENCE** Southeasterly along the last mentioned parallel line 126.62 feet more or less to the intersection of the said Southeasterly limit of said Block B.

THENCE Southwesterly along the last mentioned limit 10.07 feet more or less to the point of commencement.
