# BY-LAW

Number 57-93

To authorize the acquisition  
of property known municipally  
as 234 Main Street North and to  
repeal By-law 280-92

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of the Corporation to improve the access to and visibility of the City park located on the former Brampton Bowling Club property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The purchase of the property known municipally as 234 Main Street North, described in Schedule A, hereto is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the acquisition of the said lands.
3. By-law 280-92, which authorized the purchase of the property known municipally as 230 Main Street North, is hereby repealed.
