# BY-LAW

Number 58-2004

To amend By-law 151-88, as amended

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - (1) by changing on Sheet 23 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) and RESIDENTIAL SINGLE DETACHED D – SECTION 1231 (R1D – SECTION 1231) to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE DETACHED C – SECTION 1231 (R1C – SECTION 1231).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 2004.
