BY-LAW

Number 60-86

To amend By-law 139-84 (part of Lot 15, Concession 2, W.H.S., geographic Township of Toronto)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 139-84, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 191-85, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by changing the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY D - SECTION 592 (RID - SECTION 592).
- (2) by deleting Sheet 5 of Schedule A thereto, and substituting therefor Schedule B to this by-law.
- (3) by deleting therefrom section 591.1.2, and substituting therefor the following:

"591.1.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

(1) Minimum lot area

Interior Lot - 420 square metres
Corner Lot - 500 square metres


(2) Minimum lot width

Interior Lot - 14 metres
Corner Lot - 17 metres

(3) Minimum interior side yard width - 1.2 metres"

this 10th day of March 1986.



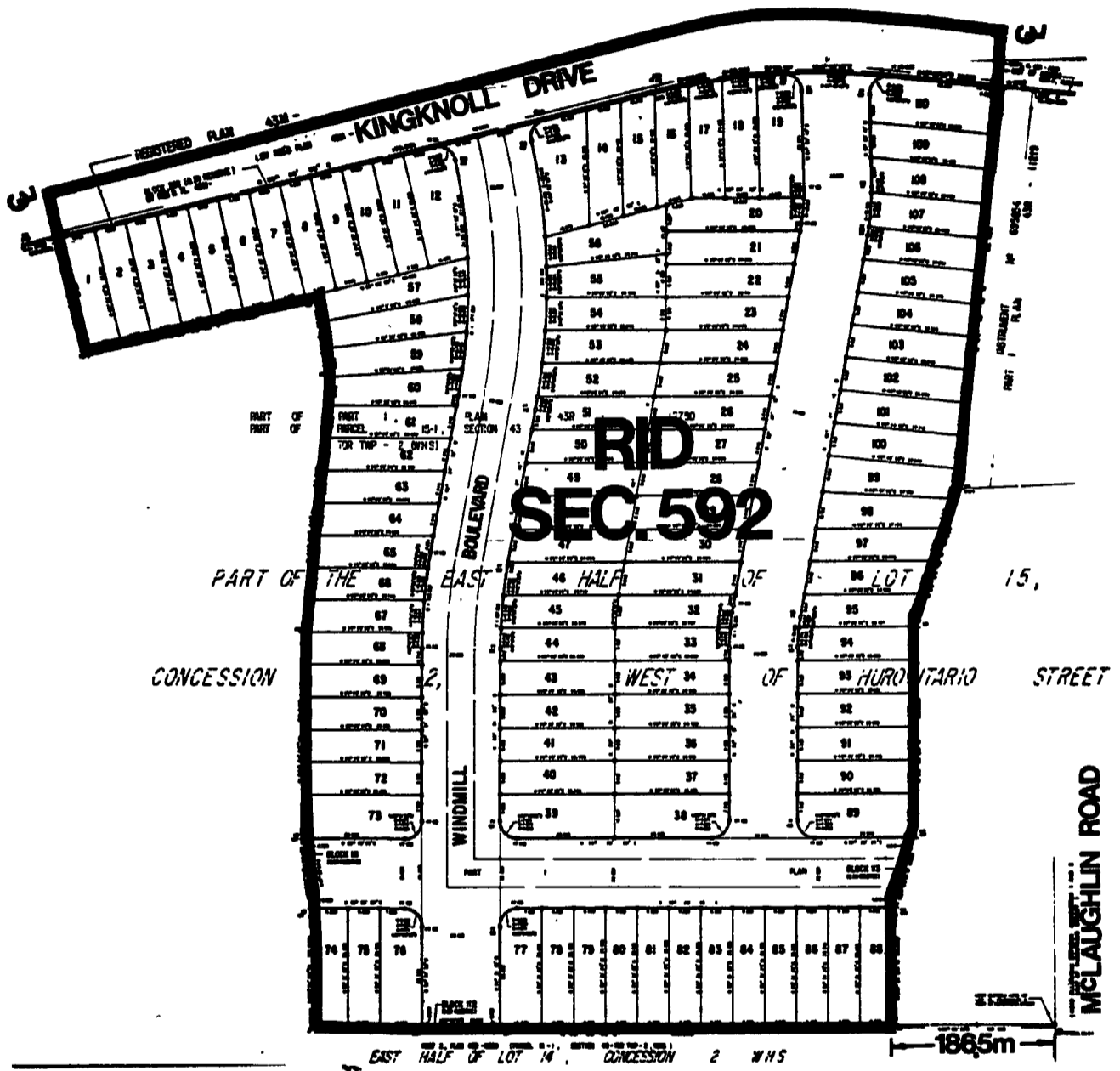

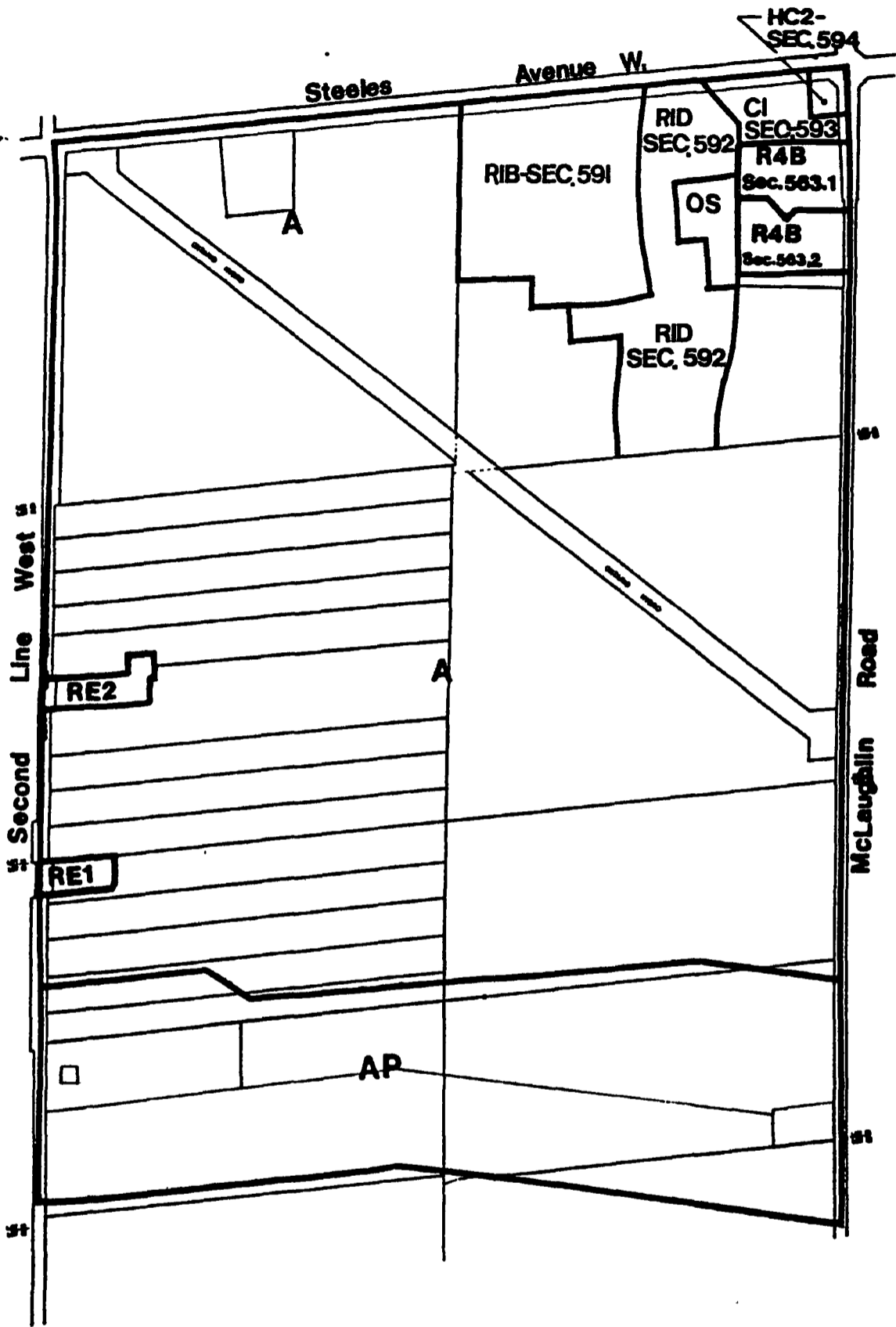
