BY-LAW

Number 60 - 2013

To amend By-law 399-2002, as amended,
The Sign By-law

WHEREAS Claireville Conservation Area is a unique use within the City of Brampton;
and

WHEREAS visibility of a ground sign is reduced due to the nature of the property; and

WHEREAS an encroachment agreement has been secured with the Region of Peel; and

WHEREAS no safety concerns were identified with the proposed location of the ground sign.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows.

THAT By-law 399-2002, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence to Schedule XIII SITE SPECIFIC PROVISIONS.

36. Notwithstanding Section 5.(5) and Schedule II GROUND SIGNS, Sentence 2.(5) the following signage adjacent to the lands described as CONC 9 ND PT LOT 5 (3805 Queen Street East) is permitted:

- a) One ground sign within the Regional right-of-way on Queen Street provided an encroachment agreement is entered into with the Region of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,
