	By-law	to	establish	remuneration

A By-law to establish remuneration for Members of Council.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of
Brampton by resolution enacted on Monday, February 28th,
1977 indicated their desire to amend the remuneration paid
to Members of Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the annual remuneration of Members of Council for The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be at the rate of \$7,250.00 effective January 1, 1977 and \$8,500.00 per annum effective January 1, 1978. The aforementioned rates of remuneration shall be subject to the approval of The Anti Inflation Board.
- 2. That the annual remuneration of Members of Council for The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall continue at the rate of \$6,000.00 per annum until altered in accordance with Anti Inflation Board approval.
- 3. That one-third of the annual remuneration of Members of Council shall be deemed to be for expenses incidental to the discharge of duties as a member of the Council.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of March, 1977.
