To amend By-law 193-83 being a by-law for the regulation of traffic.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law 193-83 being a by-law for the regulation of traffic:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by the deletion from Schedule XIX thereof the following items under the appropriate columns thereof:

RATE OF SPEED - 70 Kilometres/Hour

McLaughlin Road A point 150 metres north of Sandalwood Parkway and a point 150 metres north of Williams Pkwy

4. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by the addition to Schedule XVIII thereof the following items under the appropriate columns thereof:

RATE OF SPEED - 60 Kilometres/Hour

McLaughlin Road

A point 150 metres north of Williams Parkway
and a point 317 metres north of Holtby Avenue
