Number 64-98
To amend By-law 93-93,
HEAVY TRUCKS

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) Section 26 of By-law 93-93 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

- 26. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), when authorized signs to that effect are displayed, no person shall move, drive or operate a heavy truck on the highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule XI of this by-law between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule during the times or days set out in Column 3 of the said Schedule
(2) Subsection (1) shall not apply to any vehicle actually engaged in making delivery to or a collection from premises which cannot be reached except by way of a highway or a portion of highway referred to in the said section or to prohibit the use of such vehicles, for such purposes, provided that, in making such delivery or collection, the said highway or portion of highway is travelled only insofar as is unavoidable in getting to and from such premises.

(2) by deleting from Schedule XI thereto the following items:

HEAVY TRUCKS

Table with 3 columns: COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY, COLUMN 2 BETWEEN, COLUMN 3 TIMES OR DAYS. Rows include Kennedy Road North and Torbram Road.

(3) by adding to Schedule XI thereto the following items:

HEAVY TRUCKS

Table with 3 columns: COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY, COLUMN 2 BETWEEN, COLUMN 3 TIMES OR DAYS. Rows include Kennedy Road North, Torbram Road, and Torbram Road.



2. Section (1), subsections (1), (2) and (3) of this by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of the Regional Municipality of Peel



(2) Subsection (1) shall not apply to any vehicle actually engaged in making delivery to or a collection from premises which cannot be reached except by way of a highway or a portion of highway referred to in the said section or to prohibit the use of such vehicles, for such purposes, provided that, in making such delivery or collection, the said highway or portion of highway is travelled only insofar as is unavoidable in getting to and from such premises.

(2) by deleting from Schedule XI thereto the following items:

Kennedy Road North	Mayfield Road and Bovaird Drive	11:00 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.
Torbram Road	Bovaird Drive and East Drive	11:00 p.m.-6:30a.m.

(3) by adding to Schedule XI thereto the following items:

HEAVY TRUCKS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN	COLUMN 3 TIMES OR DAYS
Kennedy Road North	Mayfield Road and Bovaird Drive	Anytime
Torbram Road	Bovaird Drive and Queen Street	Anytime
Torbram Road	Queen Street and East Drive	11:00 p.m.-6:30a.m.

2. Section (1), subsections (1), (2) and (3) of this by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.


