- 1) Subsection 4 of Section 29 of The Planning Act, R.S.O.
 1970, Chapter 349 as amended, does not apply to the
 lands within the registered plans described in Schedule
 "A" attached hereto.
- 2) This By-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Ministry of Housing.
