BY-LAW

Number _____66-84___

To prevent the application of Part Lot Control to certain lands within Brampton (Moorville Properties Inc.)

WHEREAS subsection 49 (5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, <u>1983</u>, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49 (7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, 1983, the council of the municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 5 of section 49 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, 1983, does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of March, 1984.


SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW 66-84
