



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 66-85


To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day (Bingo Lottery - Elizabeth Fry Society)


WHEREAS the Elizabeth Fry Society proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 7:00 o'clock and 10:30 o'clock in the evening on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by the Elizabeth Fry Society, at Bingo Country, 291 Rutherford Road in Brampton.
2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
