# BY-LAW

Number 69-95

To declare surplus and authorize  
the conveyance of Part of Lot 5,  
Concession 7 Northern Division

---

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is appropriate to declare surplus and convey to the Regional Municipality of Peel the part of Lot 5, Concession 7 Northern Division designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-20896 for the purposes of widening Airport Road.

The said lands presently comprise part of Woodhill Pioneer Cemetery, so it is necessary that the conveyance be conditional on all required approvals under the Cemeteries Act (Revised) being obtained.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:


1. The lands comprising part of Woodhill Pioneer Cemetery described as part of Lot 5, Concession 7 Northern Division, designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-20896, are hereby declared surplus.
2. Section 1 of this by-law comes into force only upon:
  - (1) the order of the Registrar under the Cemeteries Act (Revised) closing the said part of Woodhill Pioneer Cemetery coming into force; and
  - (2) all human remains having been disinterred from the said part of Woodhill Pioneer Cemetery and reinterred elsewhere in the said cemetery, in accordance with the Cemeteries Act (Revised).
3. Upon section 1 of this by-law coming into force, the conveyance of the said lands to the Regional Municipality of Peel is hereby authorized. The consideration for the conveyance shall be the payment by the Regional Municipality of Peel of the costs of erecting a chain link fence and gate around the perimeter of Woodhill Pioneer Cemetery (including Block 18 on Plan 43M-879 if the expansion of the cemetery to include these lands is approved by the Registrar) and the costs of erecting a suitable historical plaque in the cemetery.
4. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the conveyance of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of March, 1995.
