To amend By-law 200-82 (part of Lot 7, Concession 1, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing on sheet 9 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from OPEN SPACE (OS) to INSTITUTIONAL TWO-SECTION 292 (12-SECTION 292), such lands being part of Lot 7, Concession 1, east of Hurontario Street, in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy.
 - (2) by adding thereto the following section:
 - The lands designated I2 Section 292 on Sheet 9 of Schedule A to this by-law:
 - 292.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:
 - (1) purposes permitted by section 40.2.1(c)
 - (2) a fire station
 - (3) a combined fire station and recreation facility
 - (4) proposes accessory to the other permitted purposes
 - 292.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

- (1) Minimum front yard depth 10 metres
- (2) Minimum rear yard 20 metres
- (3) Minimum side yard width
 - a) east side 7.5 metres
 - b) west side 15.0 metres.

shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the I2 zone, and all the general provisions of this by-law, which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 292.2."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,


