WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating lots and maintenance/servicing easements to facilitate townhouse dwelling units on Blocks 429, 430, and 431 and to create maintenance easements to facilitate single detached dwellings on Lots 74, 75, 78, 79, 82, 83, 85, 88, 122, 123, 124, 131, 132, 135, 136, 143, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 159, 160, 162, 165, 166, 167 and 168, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 74, 75, 78, 79, 82, 83, 85, 88, 122, 123, 124, 131, 132, 135, 136, 143, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 159, 160, 162, 165, 166, 167 and 168 and on Blocks 429, 430, and 431 on Registered Plan 43M-1667.
