

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 72 - 2008

To authorize receipt of Provincial Funding for Municipal Transit Capital Expenditures

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has committed one-time funding to improve and expand public transit in the 2007 Ontario Economic Outlook and Fiscal Review ("Fall Economic Statement");

AND WHEREAS through the Fall Economic Statement the Province is committing to provide funding for municipal transit capital expenditures to the City of Brampton in the amount of \$4,162,276.00;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$4,162,276.00 from the Province of Ontario committed through the Province's Fall Economic Statement on the condition that the funding amount will be:
  - a. Used for municipal transit capital expenditures;
  - b. Audited by the City's external auditor and reported to the Ministry on an annual basis; and
  - c. Deducted, in full or in part, from future provincial transit funding allocations, if the City is found to not be in compliance with the terms set out in a. and b. above.
- 2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, any other documents required to give effect to this By-Law.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2008.
