BY-LAW

Number 74 - 2006

To authorize the execution of an Agreement with the Ministry of Transportation for the construction of the Highway 410 overpass and Approach Roads

WHEREAS the Ministry of Transportation is responsible for the design and construction of the extension of Highway $\hat{4}10$ between Bovaird Drive and Highway 10;

AND WHEREAS Phase II of this project includes a 2-lane overpass at Countryside Drive;

AND WHEREAS the City of Brampton's Countryside Drive Environmental Assessment Study confirms that Countryside needs to be widened to a 4-lane arterial road;


AND WHEREAS the construction schedules of the Ministry of Transportation and the City a relatively close together for this road work;

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Transportation has agreed to include the City's request of the widening of the overpass and approach roads of Countryside to 4-lanes within the Ministry's construction project, provided the City agrees, in a formal agreement, to pay for the incremental costs associated with the widening.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the MTO, in a form acceptable to the City's solicitor and on terms satisfactory to the Commissioner of Works and Transportation, to provide for the construction of the widening of the 410 overpass at Countryside and the approach roads from two lanes to four lanes, by the MTO, at an estimated cost of \$3.0 million to the City, such cost to include all structural work and property acquisition.
- 2. Staff shall request additional authorization from Council should the costs exceed the estimated \$3,000,000.
