BY-LAW

15-81	
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To amend By-law 861, as amended, (part of Lot 5, Concession 6, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 861, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by deleting therefrom section 217.1.1(d), and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(d) cinemas"
 - (2) by adding thereto section 217.1.1(e):
 - "(e) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes"
 - (3) by deleting therefrom section 217.1.2(e) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(e) maximum building height: 10 metres"
 - (4) by deleting therefrom section 217.1..2(f) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(f) minimum setbacks:

from Highway Number 7 - 13 metres from Gateway Boulevard - 9 metres from Summerlea Road - 7 metres from other site limits - 4.5 metres

- (5) by adding thereto the following after section 217.1.2(f):
 - "(g) the total number of seats for cinema purposes shall not exceed 1490 seats,

(h) a minimum of 250 off-street parking spaces shall be provided for cinema purposes."
