## **BY-LAW**

Number	75-93

To provide for certain matters under the Line Fences Act and to amend By-law 70-91

The Council of The Corporation of City of Brampton has determined that it is advisable and in the interests of the Corporation to fix the remuneration paid to fence-viewers and the administrative fee payable to the Corporation for proceedings under the <u>Line Fences Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.L.17 and to provide that no proceeding requiring the attendance of the fence-viewers shall be scheduled during the winter months.

THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Each fence-viewer shall receive remuneration of \$30.00 (Thirty Dollars) for each attendance or reattendance by that fence-viewer in a proceeding under the Line Fences Act. The fence-viewer who writes up the award and personally delivers it to the City Clerks Department shall receive additional remuneration of \$5.00 (Five Dollars).
- 2. The administrative fees to be paid to The Corporation of the City of Brampton in relation to proceedings under the Line Fences Act is hereby fixed at \$55.00 (Fifty-five Dollars).
- 3. By-law 70-91 is hereby amended by deleting sections 2 and 3.
- 4. No arbitration or other proceeding under the Line Fences Act that requires the attendance or reattendance of the fence-viewers shall be scheduled between the 1st day of November in any year and the 31st day of March in the next following year.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of April, 1993.
