

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number ______75-2000

To establish certain lands as part of the public highway known as Royal Orchard Drive, Brampton

WHEREAS certain lands owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton legally described as Part of Block 261, Registered Plan 43M-1076 designated as Part 36 on Plan 43R-24245, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Lands") form part of a 0.30 m reserve fronting a portion of Block 253, Registered Plan 43M-1076 and adjoining Royal Orchard Drive;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that the Lands are no longer required to be retained as a 0.30 m reserve;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Lands are hereby established as part of the public highway system.

2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such further instruments as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in open Council this 26th day of April, 2000.
