
WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that an un-used portion of the Donwoods Court road allowance adjacent to 14 Donwoods Court, being Parts 1, 2 and 3, on Plan 43R-28616, be stopped up and closed so that it can be used for the construction of the Donwoods Parkette:



NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the lands known municipally as Donwoods Court, being designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-28616, City of Brampton, Region of Peel, be stopped up and closed so that it can be used for the construction of the Donwoods Parkette.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute all documents required to give effect to this by-law.
