certain activities on the Lord's
Day


WHEREAS the Kinsmen Club of Brampton Incorporated proposes to hold part of its annual exhibition and show on Sunday, the 6th day of May 1984;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of The Lords's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980,c.253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by the Kinsmen Club of Brampton in the north parking lot of Bramalea City Centre, in the City of Brampton, and in respect of all activities provided in connection therewith, including the operation of a "midway" with shows, rides, games and concessions.
2. The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall be permitted after 12:00 o'clock noon, on Sunday, the 6th day of May, 1984, but nothing in this section shall in any way limit the time during which the Kinsmen Club may conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful under The Lord's Day Act (Canada).
