BY-LAW

Number 78-2006

A By-law to amend By-law 26-2006 by deleting the appointment of P. Cassata as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Brampton during the period commencing on March 6, 2006 and ending on March 31, 2006

WHEREAS under Section 224 of the *Municipal Act*, it is the role of Council to ensure that administrative procedures are put into place to implement the decisions of Council;

AND WHEREAS under Section 227 of the *Municipal Act*, it is the role of employees of the municipality to carry out duties assigned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS P. Cassata is currently an employee of the City in the enforcement section of Legal Services and is taking a college cooperative placement that requires him to conduct by-law and other *Provincial Offences Act* prosecutions, for which he will receive credit for his diploma;

AND WHEREAS By-law 26-2006 appoints P. Cassata as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer.


AND WHEREAS the Section 2.5.1 of Schedule 1 of the Streamlining of the Administration of the Provincial Offences Act Memorandum of Understanding, ("MOU") signed between the City and the Province of Ontario states that any person employed as a prosecutor shall not be also be employed as an enforcement officer;


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of February, 2006.
