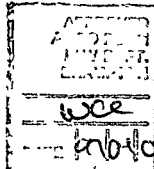
To stop up and close and authorize the sale of part of Garden Avenue, Murray Street and Greenleaf Crescent on Registered Plan 43M-476

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The parts of the public highways described below are hereby stopped up and closed:
 - (a) the part of Garden Avenue on Registered Plan 43M-476 designated as Parts 1 and 3 on Plan 43R-22124;
 - (b) the part of Murray Street on Registered Plan 43M-476 designated as Parts 6 and 9 on Plan 43R-22124;
 - (c) Block 61 on Registered Plan 43M-476, which was established as part of Murray Street by By-law 42-88 registered as Instrument No. LT855940; and
 - (d) the part of Greenleaf Crescent on Registered Plan 43M-476 designated as Part 12 on Plan 43R-22124.
2. The sale of the lands described in section 1 of this by-law, are declared surplus and the sale of the said lands, together with the part of Block A on Registered Plan BR-25 designated as Parts 2, 8 and 11 on Plan 43R-22124, to Norman S. Broz in Trust, or to such person or persons as he might direct, for a total price of \$30,000 plus G.S.T. is hereby authorized.
3. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule A forms part of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of April, 1997.

2. A public notice of Brampton City Council's intention to pass this by-law was published in the Brampton Guardian on the dates listed below:



Wednesday, April 2, 1997.



In accordance with Section 44 of the Regional Municipalities Act, a letter was personally delivered from The Corporation of the City of Brampton to the Regional Municipality of Peel advising the Region of the City's intention to stop up and close the part of Queen Street West described in this by-law. The Regional Municipality of Peel has advised that it has no objection to the said stopping up of part of Garden Avenue, Murray Street and Greenleaf Crescent.

4. The matter of the stopping up, closing and sale of the part of Garden Avenue, Murray Street and Greenleaf Crescent described in this by-law came before City Council at its meeting of the 14th day of April, 1997. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.

5. The owners of the abutting lands, Bozena Luba and Henryk Luba and Surjit Gill, Ajaib Gill and Shinder Singh, have assigned their respective rights to purchase the parts of the closed highways described in this by-law to Norman S. Broz in Trust.
