	BY-LAW
	Number 81-91 To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on The Lord's Day
	WHEREAS the Kinsmen Club of Brampton/Bramalea proposes to hold part of its annual exhibition and show on Sunday, the 14th day of July 1991.
	NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:
	1. Section 6 of <u>The Lord's Day (Ontario)Act</u> , (R.S.O. 1970, C. 59, as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by The Kinsmen Club of Brampton/Bramalea at Shoppers World 499 Main St. S. Brampton, Ontario, and in respect of all activities provided in connection therewith, including the operation of a "midway" with shows, rides, games and concessions.
	2. The activities specified in Section 1 of this By-law shall be permitted after the hour of 12:00 noon Sunday the 14th day of July 1991, but nothing in this Section shall in any way limit the time during which the said Kinsmen Club of Brampton/Bramalea conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful under the <u>The Lord's Day Act</u> (Canada).
	3. Kinsmen Club of Brampton/Bramalea shall conduct the activities hereby permitted in an orderly manner.
	READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of April 1991.
