

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 82-75

A By-law to prohibit the sale of refreshments or confections, including fruit, candy, peanuts, popcorn, ice cream, ice cream cones, iced milk and other iced confectionery from a basket or wagon, cart or other vehicle upon any highway or part of it or in a public park or other public place in the City of Brampton.


WHEREAS Section 381 (1) 3 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 as amended, provides that the Corporation may pass by-laws prohibiting the sale of refreshments or confections, including fruit, candy, peanuts, popcorn, ice cream, ice cream cones, iced milk and other iced confectionery from a basket or wagon, cart or other vehicle upon any highway or part of it or in any public park or other public place.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. In this by-law "highway" means a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle designed and intended for, or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes all of the public road allowance.
2. In this by-law "vehicle" includes a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power but does not include a motorized snow vehicle or the ones of electric or steam railways running only upon rails.
3. No person shall sell, or offer for sale, refreshments or confections including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, fruit, candy, peanuts, popcorn, ice cream, ice cream cones, iced milk and other iced confectionery from a basket or wagon, cart or other vehicle upon any highway or part of it or in any public park or other public place in the City of Brampton.

4. This by-law shall not apply to a farmer, market gardener or other person selling or delivering goods at any place of business or residence upon such highway or part thereof.
5. Any person convicted of a contravention of this by-law shall forfeit and pay a fine not exceeding the sum of \$1000.00 (One Thousand Dollars) exclusive of costs and the provisions of The Summary Convictions Act. shall apply thereto.
6. That By-law Number 2532 of the former Town of Brampton be and is hereby repealed.
