BY-LAW

82-87 Number

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan BR-35 (Bramwest Developments)

WHEREAS subsection 49(5) of the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u> has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, <u>1983</u>, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- Subsection 5 of section 49 of the <u>Planning</u> <u>Act, 1983</u> (S.O. 1983, c.1, as amended) does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

Schedule A to By-law 82-87

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

Part of Lots 99, 100 and 101 and Part of Haggert Avenue, according to a plan of survey of Part of the east half of Lot 6, in the First Concession West of Hurontario Street by C. J. Wheelock, P.L.S.

Registered September 1884 and now referred to as Plan BR-35.

Being Parts 1 to 6 (both inclusive), Plan 43R-14329.
