BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 5500 AS AMENDED

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1) Map 46 of Schedule 'B' attached to By-law 5500 is hereby amended by changing thereon the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule 'A' attached hereto from A to ACI-SECTION 764.
- 2) By-law 5500 is amended by adding thereto the following section:

"Part of Lot 15, Concession 3, E.H.S.

- 764.1 The land designated ACI-SECTION 764 on Schedule 'B' attached hereto:
  - 764.1.1 shall only be used for a restaurant and its accessory uses.
  - 764.1.2 shall be subject to the following restrictions and requirements:
    - a) a minimum front yard of 15.2 metres (50 feet) shall be provided.
    - b) a minimum side yard of 5.1 metres (17 feet) shall be provided.
    - c) a minimum rear yard of 4.8 metres (16 feet) shall be provided.
    - d) a minimum of one parking space for each 17 square metres (56 square feet) of gross floor area shall be provided.
  - 764.1.3 shall also be subject to those restrictions and requirements relating to an ACl zone which are not in conflict with the ones set out in Section 764.1.2.

764.2 In this section, the following definitions shall apply:

Restaurant shall mean an establishment which has full kitchen facilities for the preparation of various types of meals and whose business is the preparation and sale of such types of meals, to be served by a restaurant employee at the same table where the food is to be consumed."

3) This By-law shall not come into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 23rd day of April 1979.


