# BY-LAW

Number 84-82

To prevent the application of part lot control to certain lands (Block 00, Registered Plan 977 - Bramalea Limited)

WHEREAS subsection 29(5) of the Planning Act, (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 379, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 29(10) of the Planning Act, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 29 of the Planning Act does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A attached hereto.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.
