A by-law to provide for voter information to be translated into other languages for 2014 City of Brampton Municipal Election and to repeal By-law 41-2010

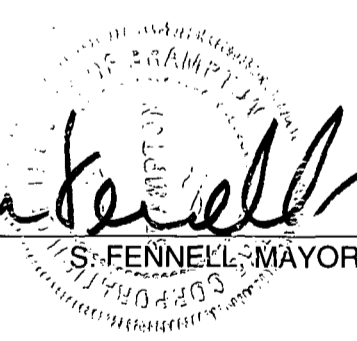
WHEREAS Section 9(2) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law allowing the use of French and other languages other than English on information provided to voters;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That voter information for the 2014 Municipal Election conducted under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* be translated into those languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the population of the City of Brampton according to the most recent Census, plus French; and
2. That By-law 41-2010 be repealed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of April, 2014.
