



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 86-83

To amend By-law 33-79, as amended,
in respect of parking fines

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection (1) of section (3) of Part 6 of
By-law 33-79, as amended, is hereby repealed and
the following substituted therefor:
Notwithstanding section (1) of Part 6 of this
by-law, any person may, upon presentation at the
offices of The Corporation of the City of Brampton,
of a violation tag alleging the contravention of
any of the parking, standing or stopping provisions
of this by-law, pay to the City of Brampton within
five (5) days exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays or
holidays from the date of issue of the violation
tag, a penalty of:
 - (a) Three Dollars (\$3.00) in respect of an alleged
violation of the provisions relating to parking
meters, and
 - (b) Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in respect of an alleged
violation of the provisions relating to parking,
excluding parking meters and the parking of heavy
vehicles, and


(c) Seven Dollars (\$7.00) in respect of an alleged violation of the provisions relating to standing, and
(d) Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in respect of an alleged violation of the provisions relating to stopping, and
(e) Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) in respect of an alleged violation of the provisions relating to parking or standing so as to interfere with the clearing of snow from a highway, and
(f) Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) in respect of an alleged violation of the provisions relating to the parking of heavy vehicles,
and upon such payment, no further proceedings shall be taken under this by-law in respect of the offence alleged in the violation tag.

2. Section (1) of Part 6 of By-law 33-79, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- (1) Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and upon conviction, is liable to a penalty of not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), exclusive of costs, for the first offence, and not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), exclusive of costs, for each subsequent offence.
