
1. Amendment Number OP93- 182 to the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby adopted and made part of this by-law.



AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93 - 182  
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE  
CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to revise the City of Brampton Official Plan, to designate a section of Kennedy Road south of Steeles Avenue East as a Minor Arterial Road with an ultimate right-of-way of 36 metres in order to conform to the classification of Kennedy Road as designated in the Fletchers Creek Secondary Plan (Area 24) and the Steeles Industrial South Secondary Plan (Area 25).

2.0 Location:

This amendment affects the section of Kennedy Road between Steeles Avenue East and the Brampton/Mississauga municipal boundary. Specifically, it will affect the portions of land that extend 18 metres to the east and west of the centre line of Kennedy Road.

3.0 Amendments and Policies Relative Thereto:

3.1 The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning area is hereby amended:

- (1) by amending on Schedule "B" - Major Road Network Right-Of-Way Widths thereto, the designation and right-of-way width of Kennedy Road between Steeles Avenue East and the Brampton/Mississauga municipal boundary as a Minor Arterial and 36 metres, respectively.

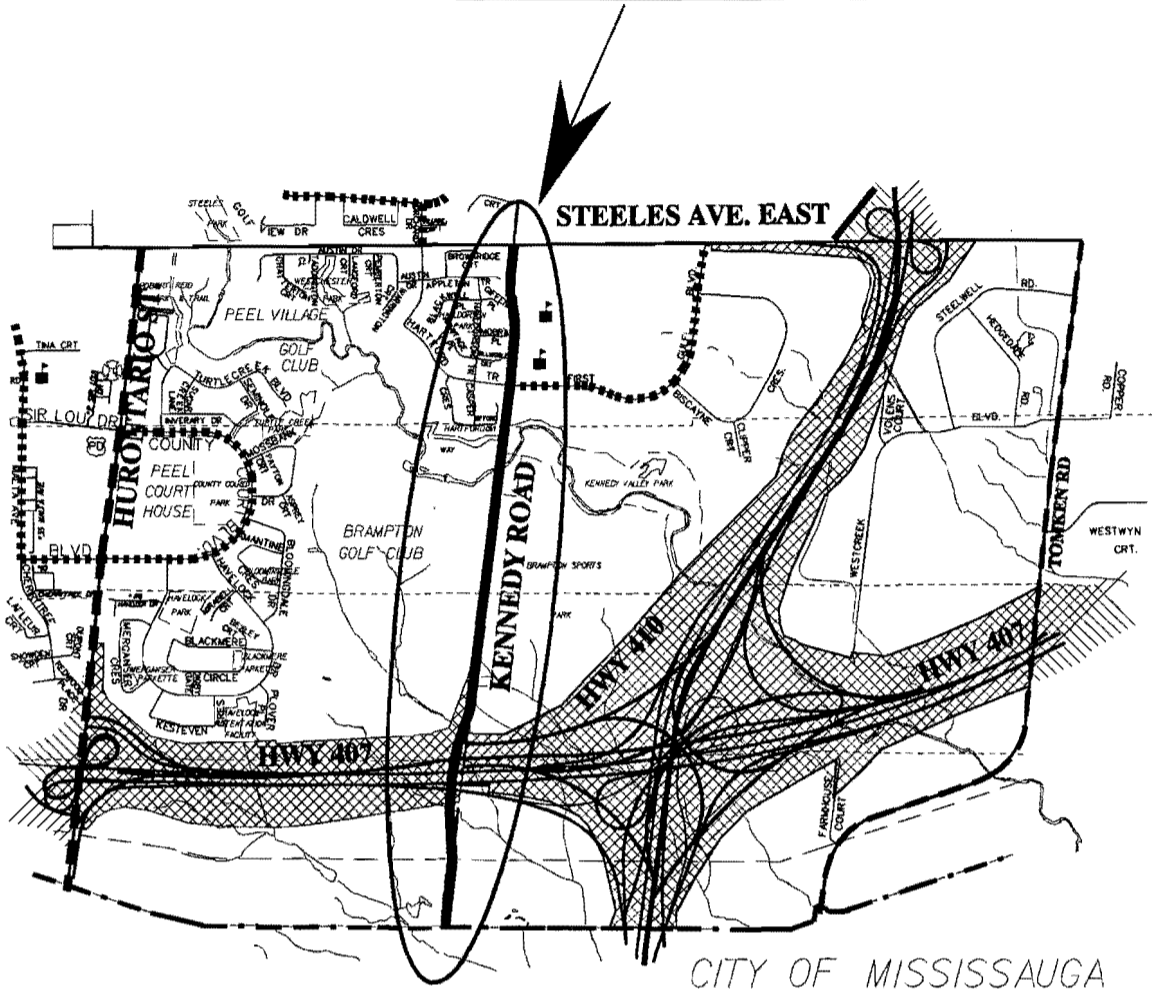

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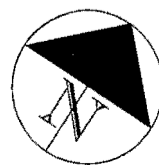

I, LEONARD JOSEPH MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton, in the Region of Peel, do solemnly declare:


