To exempt from City taxation, Branches 15 and 609 of the Royal Canadian Legion

WHEREAS section 207 (62) of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 and amendments thereto, permits a municipality to exempt from taxation, except for local improvements and school purposes for a period not exceeding ten (10) years, any premises actually used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse, or atheletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in any war;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to provide a tax exemption from City taxation.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. THAT the Treasurer is authorized to allow a tax exemption from City taxation on the premises of the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 15 at 40 Elizabeth Street South, and on the premises of the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 609 at 1133 Queen Street East, provided that:
 - they are used and occupied as a clubhouse by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in war;
 - the exemption does not include local improvement charges, taxes levied for school purposes, or taxes levied for the purposes of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
- 2. This By-law shall remain in force from year to year until repealed, but shall not remain force after the year 2005.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and passed in Open Council this $10 \, \text{th}$ day of APRIL, 1995.
