### **BY-LAW**

Number	90-80	

To restrict vehicle loads to 5 tonnes per axle during March and April

WHEREAS Subsection 10 of Section 77 of The Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1979, Chapter 202, as amended) provides that the municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over any highway may declare the provision of subsections 5, 7 and 13 to apply to highways under its jurisdiction during any period of the year;

AND WHEREAS restriction of loads is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the City of Brampton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The provisions of Subsection 5 of Section 77 of The Highway Traffic Act shall extend and apply, during the months of March and April of each year, to the Highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule A to this By-law, between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said schedule, when appropriate signs have been erected.
- 2. The provisions and penalties in Subsection 13 of Section 77 of <u>The Highway Traffic Act</u> shall apply to contraventions of this by-law.
- 3. This by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.
- 4. By-law Number 57-76 is hereby repealed.
