BY-LAW

Number	92-88	

To change the name of part of Nelson Street

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of part of Nelson Street;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in The Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- The name of the part of Nelson Street described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby changed to "Wilson Avenue".
- The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in open Council this 11th day of April, 1988.

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel), being the part of Nelson Street according to Registered Plan BR-13 situated between the westerly limit of Centre Street according to Registered Plan BR-13 and the easterly limit of Scott Street according to Registered Plans BR-13 and BR-15.

SCHEDULE B to By-law 92-88

- A public notice respecting the street name change of parts of Nelson Street was advertised, in the form attached as Exhibit A to my affidavit, in the Brampton Guardian on the following dates:

 - ii) Wednesday, February 24, 1988; iii) Wednesday, March 2, 1988; and iv) Wednesday, March 9, 1988.
- No person applied to be heard in respect of the change of street name at the Council meeting of March 21, 1988. By inadvertence, the by-law to change the name of part of Nelson Street was not listed on the agenda for the March 21, 1988 Council meeting, so the by-law was placed on the April 11, 1988 agenda.
