

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 92 - 2008

To authorize receipt of provincial funding through the Metrolinx Bikelinx Program

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario through the Metrolinx Bikelinx Program has approved funding to the City to enhance the links between active transportation and public transit, and in particular has approved \$319,200 for bicycle racks on buses and \$112,181 for secure and safe bicycle parking,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City is authorized to accept said funds from Metrolinx on the basis that the funds will be:
 - a. Used to purchase and install bicycle racks on buses and well as secure and safe bicycle parking as defined by Metrolinx; and
 - b. Deducted, in full or in part, from future provincial transit funding allocations, if the City is found to not be in compliance with the terms set out above.
- 2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, any other documents required to give effect to this By-Law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of April, 2008.
