Being a By-law to Amend By-law Number 251-75.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1) Schedule 'A' attached to By-law Number 251-75 shall be deleted and replaced with Schedule 'A' hereto attached and forming part of this By-law.
- 2) A new Section shall be added between Sections 5 and 6 of By-law Number 251-75 as follows:
 - 5A No person shall within a Residential Multiple RMIC

 Zone, erect or use any building or structure or use
 any land, in whole or in part, for any purpose other
 than in accordance with the provisions of a RMIC Zone
 except that in addition thereto, the following provisions
 shall apply:

Regulations:

Front Yard Landscaped Open Space not less than fifty (50) per cent of the area of a required front yard shall be maintained as landscaped open space.

Minimum Side Yard Flanking Road Allowance 10 feet

Minimum Corner Lot Vision Angle

No part of any building on corner lot shall be located closer than 20 feet from the intersection of street lines as projected.

Accessory buildings shall be permitted subject to the following regulations:

Maximum Floor Area

10 per cent lot area but

not exceeding 120 square feet.

Maximum Height

7 feet

Such buildings shall be permitted only in the rear yard with a minimum distance from any lot line of 2 feet.

The following shall apply for corner lots:

Minimum Lot Area

3,000 square feet

Minimum Lot Frontage Per Dwelling Unit 30 feet

Driveways

No driveway shall be located closer than twenty (20) feet

from the corner

Front Yard and Flanking Side Yard Landscaped Open Space Not less than sixty (60) per cent of the area of a required front yard shall be maintained as landscaped open space and not less than eighty (80) per cent of the area of a required flanking side yard shall be maintained

as landscaped open space.

3) This By-law shall not come into force unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL this 22nd day of March, 1976.
